



GENUINE LEATHER

During the daily use of leather furniture pieces, the following rules must be respected. Avoid prolonged exposure to sunlight. As with any other material, prolonged exposure to sunlight causes discoloration. Some leather types are more sensitive than others, for example, suede leather items - with a velvety appearance - and leather in blue, green, and red tones. Regular use of leather items is recommended. These are able to mold to the body, providing a unique comfort. The continued friction in a localized way can cause undesirable changes in the leather. Avoid contact with beauty products as these are likely to cause blemishes or other undesirable effects. To clean small surface stains use a soft, slightly damp cloth (if using any detergent, use one with neutral pH). Furniture upholstery must be hydrated with specific products indicated for this purpose. Consult the seller about the most suitable procedures and products. Leather items must be dried at room temperature, away from any artificial heat sources. Before applying any cleaning or maintenance product, test it on a non-visible part of the furniture piece. Consult the seller for advice on the precautions to be taken to keep the product in good condition.

UPHOLSTERY

Care for upholstery items by vacuuming or lightly brushing. Keep them away from direct sunlight. The nap of high pile textiles such as velvets may become crushed or lose their original pile height. We recommend light steaming to lift the pile to its original height. Water-based or solvent cleaners may cause discoloration or staining. We recommend that stained upholstery items be cleaned by certified professionals.

SOLID WOOD

We recommend daily cleaning using a well-wrung cloth and clean water. Avoid products containing any kind of chemicals. Wood should not be exposed to excessive heat, direct sunlight, or humidity. Please note that due to its organic nature, wood varies from furniture to furniture in its veins and tonality and may become weathered, or the fibers may rise slightly. Over time, it will show signs of natural aging.

WOOD VENEER

Wood veneer furniture is made from thin sheets of natural wood. They are easy to clean, and very durable. Remove dust with a soft cloth weekly. When necessary, clean with a moist cloth and dry immediately with a soft cloth. Wood veneer should not be exposed to excessive heat, direct sunlight, or humidity. Avoid using products containing any kind of chemicals.

MARBLE

For marble surfaces, dust weekly with a soft cloth, and monthly with a dampened cloth with warm water. If necessary, add a small squeeze of a special anti-stain and anti-oil product. Do not use abrasive cloths or sponges which may scratch the

surface. Never use acidic detergents or bleach. To avoid everyday damage, use coasters and placemats to protect from anything that may scratch the surface.

BRASS

For cleaning and maintenance only use a cotton cloth dampened with water or specific neutral products for brass. Do not use abrasive cloths, solvents, alcohol, or strong detergents. Dry the surface thoroughly in case of contact with water. To clean small surface stains use a soft, slightly damp cloth (if using any detergent, use one with neutral pH); Car and furniture upholstery must be hydrated with products specially indicated for this purpose. Check with the seller about the most suitable procedures and products. Leather items must be dried at room temperature, away from any heat sources. Before applying any cleaning or maintenance product, test it on a non-visible part of the product.

STAINLESS STEEL

Use a soft dry cloth to clean the details and feet in stainless steel, on MOOZA's pieces. Do not use chemical or abrasive cleaners and avoid using water. Please note that hard polishing will damage the surface. Dry the surface thoroughly in case of contact with water.

NICKEL

Use a microfiber cloth to wipe nickel structures with warm water. To clean stains and help restore shine to the finish use a damp cloth in one part vinegar and three parts water. Dry it thoroughly with a dry microfiber cloth to avoid any stains and streaks.

WOOL

Wool rugs are for indoor use only. We recommend occasional professional cleaning. As wool is made from natural fibers, it can cause unpleasant odors, when in contact with water. Make sure to properly dry it. Do not dry-clean in any circumstance.

MIRROR GLASS

To clean mirror glass, use a soft clean cloth wrung with warm water. Do not use acidic, abrasive or alkaline cleaners on the mirror. For more thorough cleaning, use commercial glass cleaners without ammonia or vinegar.

GLASS

To avoid stains and damage to the glass surfaces, use cleaning solutions recommended specifically for glass cleaning and a soft microfiber towel. Do not use abrasive detergents or others which contain hydrofluoric or phosphoric acid. To clean the opal glass in MOOZA's lighting fixtures rub the glass with a slightly damp, lint-free cloth.
